OHIO RIVER SCENIC RAILWAY


The Ohio River Scenic Railway ("ORSR") operates a variety of excursion train rides tailored for passengers of all ages, based out of Tell City, Indiana.

16,694 Passengers

Despite opening immediately prior to the global COVID-19 pandemic, our company managed to safely accommodate **7,957 passengers** in **2020** and **8,737 passengers** in **2021**.

The current outlook for projected ridership in 2022 is **21,600 riders** by year end.





Tourism

87% of riders in 2021 resided outside of Perry & Spencer counties and traveled from 25 different states.



13 Employees

2022 boasts paid positions for three (3) full-time and ten (10) part-time employees.



25+ Local Vendors

ORSR has cultivated relationships with over 25 local vendors to provide goods and services related to the train rides.

SLW is a local 501(c)3 nonprofit partner which has licensed ORSR to, and retains the rights for, operate passenger rail service, authorized by the Perry County Port Authority.





\$1.7 Million Impact

Industry and company specific data suggests that ORSR currently generates \$1.7+ million in annual local economic impact from train tourism.
